Toubkal massif

The Atlas range is an extensive mountains chain of 2400 kilometers length, which runs through North Africa from Tunisia to Morocco. It is in this country where the Atlas reaches its greatest heights south of Marrakech city, in the massif known as the High Atlas.

Its culminating point is the **Jbel Toubkal, 4167 meters**, which with the neighbors Timesguida (4089 m), Ras (4083 m), Afella (4043 m), Akioud (4030 m), and Biginouseme (4003 m), all they form a beautiful circus of high peaks.

Having the Refuge of Toubkal at 3000 m as a base camp, this area has many possibilities for trekking and mountaineering, all the year along but on Winter and Spring mainly. A eight days trip should be more than enough to thoroughly explore this area and ascend most of its summits.

Marrakech city would be the most convenient entry and exit point to access the Toubkal massif

Best season: All year along but since February to May mainly
